WATERPARK RULES

- NEVER SWIM ALONE. Lifeguards are present to monitor guest safety and should not be considered supervision for children. A supervising companion should be present with children at all times.
- THERE IS NO SUBSTITUTE FOR ADEQUATE SUPERVISION. Children under 16 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- Please secure all valuables. The Kartrite Resort is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Carry in food, drinks, breakable items, balloons, and/or coolers are not permitted in the waterpark.
- Smoking or vaping is not permitted in the waterpark. Use designated smoking areas only.
- RESORT ISSUED WRISTBANDS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES.
- Swim diapers are required for diaper-aged children or those not toilet trained. Diaper changing is prohibited on pool deck.
- Suitable swimming attire shall be worn on all water attractions. Water shoes highly recommended. Swimwear with buckles, rivets, exposed zippers, studs, sharp objects or dresses are not allowed in water attractions. Clothing that is revealing or has vulgar content is not permitted.
- Please respect the privacy of our guests. Photos/videos should be restricted to your family and friends. Conventional and cell phone cameras are prohibited in locker rooms and restrooms.
- No jumping or diving permitted. Enter only at designated entrances.
- Follow instructions given by lifeguard staff. Lifeguard rescue training may be observed during operating hours.
- A life size mannequin may be used as part of training as well as live drills and simulated incidents.
- Guests shall read all posted attraction signage prior to riding. On attractions, riders shall be in good physical condition. Pregnant guests, or guests who have or may have had heart conditions, back, neck, bone, joint, muscle, neurological or other medical problems should not ride. Please know your limitations. If you choose to use the waterpark you do so at your own risk.
- Only use this facility during posted hours of operation. Pool closures may occur for inclement weather or unfavorable water conditions.
- The Kartrite Resort is a family waterpark. Unsafe, improper or inappropriate behavior or attire will not be permitted or tolerated. Management reserves the right to remove, without refund, anyone who violates these park rules or who's actions interfere with the enjoyment of other guests.
- IN AN EMERGENCY NOTIFY THE KARTRITE STAFF AND CONTACT HELP AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. A free telephone is provided at this facility in the first aid area.
- Don't drink alcohol and swim
- No weapons of any kind are permitted.
